


"Orca Odysea"

The "Orca Odysea" is a new design innovation that sets the standard for whale watching boats in Alaska. With its 47 passenger exposed waters certification, the ability to travel with 12 passengers overhead and ADA compliancy, the vessel offers a premium whale watching opportunity.

The U.S.C.G. certified boat has an on board head, galley and a combination of booth and bus style seating. The galley was fitted with a refrigerator, microwave and a sink with hot and cold running water. Other features include wheel chair tie downs, ADA compliant head, under floor storage, a roomy interior for optimum passenger comfort and a high quality PA system designed for customers to be able to hear the captain and deckhands as they tour the Juneau area. Electrical capabilities include house batteries, a 5 Kw genset and shore power.

On board electronics include a VHF radio, depth sounder, GPS and radar plus full engine instrumentation using the new Smartcraft system offered with Cummins engines.

The propulsion package used gave the speed and range needed to offer customers the opportunity for multiple wildlife sightings while riding in comfort and still maintaining the tour's schedule.

TOUR OPERATORS – Hotels, cruise lines, resorts, and tour companies can offer unique trips to enhance the experience of their guests while the eco friendly jet units will keep wildlife safe during viewing opportunities.

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION – With its capacity to carry 47 passengers at 40 mph cruising speeds along with its low maintenance aluminum hull and efficient propulsion package, it offers an attractive alternative to buses and trains along inland and coastal waterways.
